GRL is situated to the North of Milton Keynes, with good links by road and rail

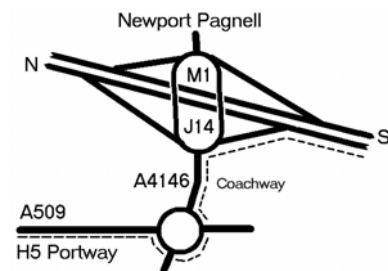
By Road

The nearest main artery is the M1. The following instructions differ initially, depending on whether you are approaching from the north or the south. The continuation instructions are common to both routes.

Milton Keynes is based on a grid of horizontal and vertical roads. The road signs for these major grid roads are labelled with a horizontal or vertical reference (H or V) and number followed by the road name, e.g. H5 Portway and V5 Great Monks St.

Travelling North

- Exit the M1 at Junction 14 in the left lane (this is a filter lane avoiding the roundabout) onto the A4146. See map 1 (right).
- Pass 'Coachway' the National Express bus terminal.
- At the next roundabout turn right onto the A509. Locally this road is known as H5 Portway
- Go straight across 9 roundabouts in sequence (covering 3.6 miles in total), until you reach the junction with the A5. This is a large roundabout/intersection at which you turn right on to the A5 Northbound.
- Follow the A5 travelling north for only 3/4 mile, leaving at the next exit.
- At the exit junction roundabout, take the 4th exit onto V5 Gt Monks St.
- Follow the continuation instructions below.



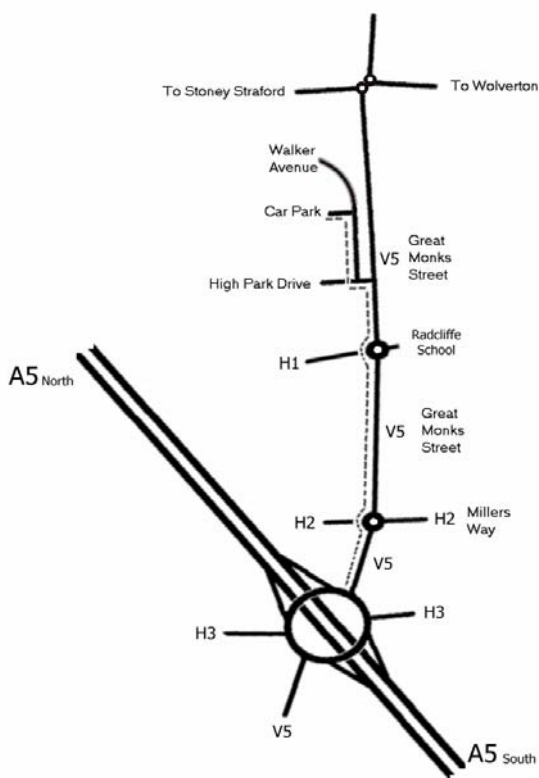
Map 1

Travelling South

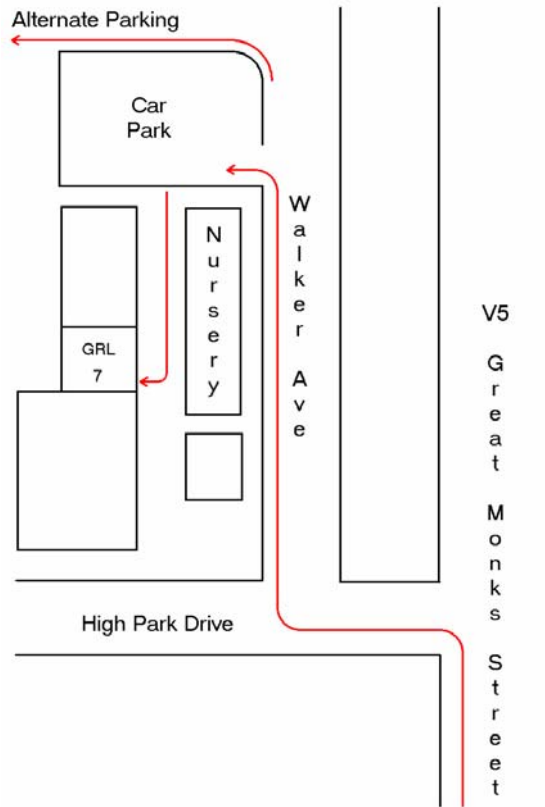
- Exit the M1 at Junction 15 and take the A508 southbound.
- After about 10 miles, Join the A5 South.
- Leave at the next junction and take the first exit onto V5 Gt Monks St.
- Follow the continuation instructions below.

Continuation Instructions

- Continue along V5, go straight on at two roundabouts (crossing H2 and then H1) and take the first turn left into 'High Park Drive' and then immediate right into Walker Avenue. See map 2 (below).
- On your left is the 'Asquith Nusery' and our offices are behind it.
- Turn left into the car park and use any space marked 'N' (We have an arrangement to use nursery parking spaces as necessary). If this carpark is full, there is alternate parking at the end of Walker Avenue. See map 3 (below).

By Rail

The mainline station at Milton Keynes is well serviced. It is a short (5 mile) ride in a taxi from the station.

Birmingham International is the only airport with a direct rail connection to Milton Keynes (journey times vary between 1hr and 2hrs with 2 or 3 trains per hour). The others listed above require travelling via London, changing trains and in some cases, additional tube travel.
